Mission Statement

At My Curious Monkey's Childcare Inc (MCMC) we strive to provide a quality part-day preschool program and a full-day program for children 18 months of age through 5 years of age. In addition to those two programs, a quality before and after school program for children of school age is available. We strive to form partnerships with all families enrolled at MCMC. We provide an environment that promotes social, emotional, physical and academic development for preschool children while allowing for differences so each child may achieve a sense of self-esteem and self-discipline. We do not provide supplementary services but can work with a parent if deemed necessary for their child to have a fully accredited (parent provided) helper to be on site.

Our Objectives

~We have a wonderful program that focus on each child's social, emotional, and intellectual skills through arts, crafts, phonics and of course imaginative and physical play.

~ To make sure children are happy, safe and well cared for by giving positive attention.

~To allow children to learn through academic and social discovery.

~ To help children learn new skills such as socializing with peers to encourage independence, and further develop communication skills.

~To acquire a sense of playfulness and wonder so that we the teachers may instill in the children a sense of curiosity, compassion, and optimism about learning.

~All with holding an open-door policy for parents to participate in parties, volunteer, or simply observe your child's activities.

Program Philosophy

My Curious Monkey's Childcare Inc is a quality preschool, childcare and afterschool program. MCMC will acknowledge religions, cultures and abilities. MCMC firmly believes that parents are the most important teachers in their children's life. As a volunteer, our program is enriched by the talents and interests' parents bring when working in the classroom. We offer parents the security of knowing that our program offers a nurturing environment and learning opportunities for their child.

Our programs at MCMC are designed to meet children's needs as well as their family's needs. We offer flexible pre-school, day care and afterschool schedules.

It is our belief that children must be free to be children and that they must be given the opportunity to grow and discover. We never shame children for making less-desirable decisions. Every child's interest is important. We acknowledge that children must learn through academic and social opportunities. The teachers provide many different opportunities for the children to gain the skills they need to succeed in a classroom environment.

How My Curious Monkey's Childcare Inc Operates

The main goal of MCMC is to work together as a team to ensure that we accomplish our mission.

The director is hired by and reports to the owner. The owner and the Director meet frequently to discuss issues such as enrollment, program coordination, staffing and the school grounds.

As a MCMC parent, you are an integral part of the school. In order to accomplish our mission, parent involvement is a must!

Parents are required to attend orientation and are encouraged to attend any parties or functions we have here at MCMC.

Communication with Parents

The owner, director and head teachers are always happy to talk to you. We try to touch base with you on a daily basis. Communication with parents is mostly through our online app or verbally. If you would like to set-up a time to talk to the director or a teacher, please contact them at any time.

Parent conferences will be scheduled as needed for those children who may need additional social and academic support. Conferences may be requested at any time by either parents or teachers. Parents will be provided with a copy of their child's assessment twice a year.

If you have questions about your child's development, please let the director or your child's head teacher know. If there is a concern about your child's behavior, your child's head teachers will set-up a time to meet with you. As a team, we will discuss a plan of action to meet your child's individual needs. It is your responsibility as the parent to keep all paper work up to date...i.e.; immunizations, emergency information etc.

Our Philosophy In

Dealing with Children's Challenging Behaviors

Our goal here at MCMC is for children to become independent and to make good choices. We assist the children by modeling appropriate behaviors and using appropriate phrases. We allow self-expression, but not if it hurts others physically or emotionally. In such cases, we do intervene. As a parent volunteering in the class, if there is a time when you are not sure how to handle a situation, please bring it to the teacher's attention.

WE NEVER USE PHYSICAL PUNISHMENT ON CHILDREN. WE NEVER INTENTIONALLY EMBARRASS A CHILD.

If necessary, we will remove a child from a group if they are in danger to themselves or others for a period of time. When the child appears to have gained control, we invite them back to the group.

Clothing

Here at MCMC we feel **PLAY IS CHILDREN'S WORK!** Their work involves paint, water, play dough, glue and dirt. Comfortable play clothes will help your child have fun and allow them to explore. We attempt to use products that washout, but sometimes depending on the fabric of clothes, the product may stain.

Ideal Clothing for MCMC

~ Closed-toed shoes.

~Pants / shorts depending on the weather.

~ Shirt

~Dresses that do not have a high value and are not too long, bloomer under may be a good idea.

PLEASE LABEL ALL YOUR CHILDREN'S CLOTHING. PLEASE BRING EXTRA CLOTHES AND LEAVE THEM IN THEIR CUBBY.

IF YOUR CHILD IS POTTY TRAINING, PLEASE BRING SEVERAL CHANGES OF SOCKS AND UNDERWEAR. LABELED!!!!

Nap Procedures

~Full-Day Childcare Children

MCMC is required by Community Care Licensing to offer children in care for more than 4 hours, a rest time. MCMC will provide the mat, yet it is your responsibility to bring your child a crib size fitted sheet and blanket. Your child's bedding will be sent home every Friday to be washed by you, the parent.

All nap items will be stored in separate labeled child's cubby to prevent any child from using other children's bedding.

If your child is enrolled in our part-time programs and you wish to extend their day, they will be required to nap/rest. Due to fire safety all children must sleep with their shoes on.

Snack / Lunch Program

Each parent is required to pack a sack lunch (usually at 11:30am) for their child to prevent any allergy issues. If a child is to forget his/her lunch they will be provided with options of: cheese, crackers, peanut butter, a fruit and/or vegetable along with milk or water. We provide a morning breakfast for those children in attendance at 7:00am and we are done by 7:30am. If your child is on a special diet, it is your responsibility to provide all said snacks and or meals for your child's days. If your child would like to bring in their own breakfast, they may, but only during breakfast time frame. Our morning and afternoon snacks consist of a carbohydrate, a dairy and a fruit or vegetable which is prepared and served daily to all children in attendance. Our snack times are at 9:00am and 3:00pm. All programs get a minimum of 1 snack, since not all programs are the length of both snack times; all day children and before school care served breakfast, after school care will get after school snack, preschool program will get an am snack, all day childcare & school age children (during summer) will get both snacks. Child must be in attendance during serving time.

Late Policy

MCMC offers many program options. If your child is in any part time program, your program begins at 8:30AM and ends at 12:00PM. If your child is in one of the full-time programs which is for all ages, your program can start as early as 6:30AM and ends no later than 6:00PM.

If you are late picking up your child you will be charged \$2 every minute the first 5 minutes and then \$5 a minute after that. The Payment is expected at the time of pick-up or by your child's next scheduled school day. If you are late more than three times in a month period, your enrollment at MCMC may be subjected to termination. We do understand that emergencies happen and would appreciate a phone call in the case of this event. However, parents will still be subjected to the late fee policy.

Days and Operation of MCMC

~ Monday - Friday 6:30AM – 6:00PM FT

~All Pre-school Programs 8:30AM – 12:00PM

The before & after school hours of operation for ages Kindergarten-12 during the regular school year differs and is according to the school schedule yet it is Monday through Friday. During summer months the before & after school program will run full-time (6:30AM – 6:00PM) in our Before & After School building.

Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures

As mandated by state licensing, each and every child must be signed in and out in the sign in/out book or clocked in by the parent/legal guardian or authorized person on emergency form using their full signature.

During drop off and pick up, please do not leave ANY CHILD unattended in your vehicle or other means of transportation. MCMC is a mandated reporting facility and will not be responsible for negligence of a parent if any harm comes to a child left alone in a vehicle.

Absent Policy

If your child is sick or unable to attend school for other reasons such as vacation, please let us know with a phone call. Occasionally, parents may have an emergency where they need their child to attend an extra day and it is helpful to know in advance if there will be space available. There are no make-up days, tuition reimbursements or reduction in hours due to absences because of illness or vacations for all MCMC programs.

Toddler Option Policy

A Child who is between 18 months and 36 months of age may participate in the toddler program with written permission from the child's authorized representative. No child in the toddler option program shall be placed in the preschool program before the age of 30 months without written permission from the child's authorized representative.

On early release days schedule will be adjusted.

On no-school days/holidays, children may attend all day if the day lands on their scheduled day.

On no-school days and summer schedule, all students must arrive at announced times to assure accurate ratios. This policy allows staff to know each day exact teacher to child ratios.

Children can only attend their scheduled days.

Every new year, child's spot is re-evaluated to confirm we can accommodate; days, times, schools, drop offs and/or pickups.

Afterschool Program & Transportation

My Curious Monkey's Childcare Inc offers transportation in our Before & Afterschool Program at selected Schools. Please see the director for School Listing. Every Year the schedule changes and each available spot is in accordance to availability and school/times of pickups/drop offs. After School parents must call the childcare if their child does NOT need transportation on a certain day(s). Each child will be picked up from his/her school and transported either by foot or in licensed MCMC vehicle. Only drivers licensed for the van (s) operating shall be permitted to transport children. MCMC cannot exceed the manufacturer's rated seating capacity of the vans. Our vans will be maintained and in safe operating conditions. All vehicle occupants shall be secured in appropriate restraint systems. Children will NOT be left in a parked car. MCMC has posted on the News Board in the front office, information on child passenger restraint systems. Any child weighing less than 80lbs. or 8 years of age in the afterschool programs will be required to have an approved child passenger restraint.

Field Trips

MCMC programs will participate in fieldtrips throughout the year. Parents will be notified in writing where and when the fieldtrip is with a permission slip to be signed and returned. The permission slip will state where the field trip is, time of departure / arrival back to school and type of transportation (walking/van). In addition, parents will be required to list at least two emergency numbers on the form. Parents are to sign and date their child's permission slip. NO CHILD will be allowed to attend a field trip if their permission slip is NOT SIGNED! Children who do NOT arrive on time for the field trip will NOT be able to attend MCMC for that day. Staff always attends fieldtrips; however, we always need parent volunteers to help. MCMC has the right to cancel a field trip if there are not enough chaperones.

Transportation Policy for Transporting Preschoolers

Children under the age of 8 years or weighing less than 80 lbs must be in an approved child passenger restraint system.

Illness Policy

A child will be considered ill and will need to stay home for 24-48 hours from last incident depending on severity and if they have one or more of the following symptoms, just a few for example; See our detailed chart at on pages 16 &17

1. A fever of 100 degrees or more
2. Green Goopy Eyes.
3. Green Goopy Noses.
4. Difficulty Breathing.
5. Unidentified Rashes.
6. Diarrhea
7. Vomiting
8. Yellowish skin tone/or eyes
9. Lice (Please see Lice Policy)
10. Lethargic

A staff member will call you if they feel your child is not feeling well. If your child develops one or more of the symptoms listed above, they will be isolated and you will be contacted to come and pick up your child within the hour of notification. If we cannot reach you, we will call the people on your emergency list. If we are unable to reach you or the people on your emergency list, we will exercise the medical consent form you signed at the time of enrollment and call 911. Any financial obligations owed to any medical agencies will be the responsibility of the parent(s).

After school students who are sent home due to sickness or because of a behavior issue from their school, may not attend the MCMC after school program that day.

Allergies

If your child has a life-threatening allergy, please let the director and your child's teacher know immediately!

They will prepare your child's snack without the ingredients that your child is allergic to. If your child is on a strict diet or has multiple allergies ie: specific milk type, gluten, vegan only etc, it will be required for you to provide all said meals and snacks for your child's day.

Medication & Medical Procedure

Staff can only administer prescribed medication from a physician in prescribed bottle. No over-the-counter medication or vitamins can be administered at school. If your child needs to have prescribed medication during school hours, please let your child's teacher know and they will ask you to fill out a "Medication Form" to describe the procedures for administering the medication. No medication can be stored in your child's cubby or attire. This is for the safety of your child and others. If your child's medication needs to be refrigerated, it must be placed in the locked medicine box located in refrigerator.

In any emergency situation, medical or dental, all medical/dental procedures will be done by staff until help arrives. We will provide CPR and or first aid, call parents and 911 when needed until medics arrive.

If it should become necessary for my/our child to receive medical attention for any reason, I/we authorize MCMC personnel to make arrangements for my/our child to receive medical care, including required transportation. I/we understand that my/our personal medical insurance acts in a primary position and agree to bare all costs incurred, this includes but not limited to contact or contractual symptoms of coronavirus. I/we hereby release My Curious Monkey's Childcare Inc and its staff from any and all liability related to personal illness, damage or injury.

Volunteering in the Classroom

If you choose to volunteer in the classroom, please notify your child's teacher of when you plan to help. When volunteering you may be asked to do one or more of the following tasks:

1. Assist the teaching staff with the daily curriculum.
2. Help supervise the playground.
3. Prepare activities that the teacher has planned.

Classroom Volunteer Policy

Upon arrival parents must check in with their child's teacher or the director. Parents will refrain from disciplining any MCMC student and must advise a teacher in handing the situation. Parent volunteers are expected to follow the class routine and are not permitted to use their cell phones when volunteering on campus.

Volunteers on Fieldtrips

Parents volunteering on fieldtrips are not permitted to use their cell phones when driving students at any time. Parents are only permitted to use their cell phones in an emergency situation during a fieldtrip.

Admissions Policy

MCMC serves children in our preschool programs ages 18 months-5 years of age. We provide before & after school care for children. Any parent interested in our programs must call the school to set-up a tour. The tour consists of meeting with the director who will explain program schedules, curriculum, and philosophy of the school. If there is available space, the director will notify the parent at that time.

Parents must fill out a registration form and pay a \$100.00 enrollment fee that is non-refundable & due annually by anniversary date of enrollment. If registration fee is waived due to a promotion or any other circumstance, parent must pay a deposit toward child's first week of tuition to hold spot. This will be applied to account once child has started and is non-refundable if child does not attend program for any reason. Once you have secured a spot for your child, parents can set-up a visiting day with their child to view the program and teacher and/ or director will assess the child to see where they will be best fit. We ask that parents stay with their child on the visiting day. Actual enrollment begins when starting date becomes available and all required licensing paperwork is completed. The following are the required forms to be filled out and signed:

Termination Policy

MCMC has the right to terminate your child's enrollment based on the following:

1. Refusal to follow all MCMC Policies and licensing regulations.
2. No tuition payment for a week or continuously chasing parent for payment
3. A child is deemed dangerous to himself/herself or others.
4. A parent is deemed inappropriate and/or dangerous to others.
5. Incomplete Admission Packet.
6. Late pick-up more than three times in a month period.

My Curious Monkey's Childcare Inc Policy on Unsafe and Inappropriate Behaviors at School

MCMC is responsible for providing a safe environment for all; preschool, all day childcare & before and after school children in our care. Biting, hitting, kicking, throwing objects at others, and spitting are considered unsafe behaviors. If your child displays any of these behaviors the child's teacher and director will meet with you the parent(s) to discuss a plan of action. The plan of action can include a behavior plan. Other actions that will be taken are suspension and possible termination of enrollment. **MCMC HAS THE RIGHT TO TERMINATE YOUR CHILD'S ENROLLMENT IF MCMC STAFF HAS EXHAUSTED ACTION PLAN(S) DISCUSSED.** MCMC will notify the parent of when this happens and reserves the right to terminate enrollment immediately.

Inappropriate Behaviors

MCMC deems the following behaviors inappropriate in our school setting: Bad language, bullying, exposing one's self, touching another student's private body parts and/or self-indulging behaviors such as fondling ones' self. If your child displays any of these behaviors the child's teacher and the director will meet with the parent(s) to discuss plan of action. The plan of action can include a behavior plan and/or a system in place. Other actions will include suspension and possible termination of enrollment if MCMC staff has exhausted action plan(s) discussed. MCMC will notify the parent of when this happens and reserves the right to terminate enrollment immediately.

In addition, parents who display inappropriate behaviors will have their child's enrollment immediately terminated. MCMC deems the following as inappropriate parent behavior: Bad language, negative postings on a social media site about MCMC, families administering physical or verbal punishment to their child or another child on MCMC property or confronting staff, neighbors and other parents inappropriately on campus of MCMC.

Tuition and Refund Policy

Tuition must be made in advance of or on the first day of the week your child attends for the week. A 5% discount will be given to the second child in multiple children family enrollment, the lesser value of the children regardless of the order of admissions. \$25.00 will be charged for each returned check. Second returned check will result in auto withdrawal, cash or cashier's check payments. Checks which are post-dated after the scheduled dates will be subjected to the late fee. There is no tuition reduction for scheduled holidays, personal vacation days, pandemic or unforeseen closures due to fire, flood or otherwise or days your child was sick. We have a no refund policy. MCMC reserves the right to close for any reason in which we cannot operate in a safe manner. I.E Loss of electricity, water, heat, air conditioning, or in an extreme circumstance medical epidemic or government shutdown. Tuition is still due during these times.

Late Fees: There will be a charge of \$25.00 for tardy tuition per week. After two weeks, child's placement in school will be terminated. A charge of \$2.00 per minute (for the first 5 minutes) will apply and price per minute will increase after those 5 minutes and applies per child upon pick up regardless of program.

Each program is priced accordingly and is written in your admission's application. Each Child must be enrolled in one program and a minimum of two days a week for preschool, three days for school ager. Prices/schedules are subject to change throughout the year. Any changes will be notified with a 30-day written notice, which includes but not limited to our annual tuition increase. Teacher and/or Director will assess your child prior to enrollment to determine the program necessary for your child.

Each student is enrolled on set days for attendance per week with a 2-day enrollment minimum. You may not switch days of care during the week or to a different day. This policy allows staff to know each day exact teacher to child ratios. If parents need an extra day of care, prior approval will be needed in order to maintain safe ratios. Parents will be billed extra hours for that extra day.

Procedures for Changing Your Child's Program

My Curious Monkey's Childcare Inc understands that you may need to change your child's schedule due to unexpected or expected circumstances. However, MCMC may not be able to accommodate your needs immediately. There may or may not be space available in the program you want to switch to. Since we do follow state ratio requirements, MCMC has a certain number of slots per program and cannot create extra slots. If the program you are requesting is full, you will be put on a waiting list, this includes school age children that go from one grade to another the following year. If there is an opening, and you are "downsizing" your child's program (i.e., switching from full-time to part-time program) you will need to give a two-week written notice and will be expected to pay your previous program amount up to the two weeks. Your new program rate will begin after the two-weeks are over. If you are "up-sizing" your child's program (i.e., switching from part-time to full-time) and there is space available, your child may start the program immediately and our bookkeeper will prorate the difference in amount due. A two-week paid, written notice for terminating your child's enrollment is required.

Lice Policy

If lice (NITS, louse, larva, bugs) are found on your child, he/she will not be able to return to MCMC for 48 hours. **There will be no exceptions to this rule.**

This is to ensure time is given to treat your child and adhere to the guidelines below before returning.

When there is an outbreak MCMC does its' part in "de-licing" the vans cleaning the carpets and surrounding areas. In addition, our staff spends a significant amount of time checking children's heads to make sure students don't have any signs of the lice cycle. When teachers are utilized to check for lice on a continuous basis it disrupts the other schedule which students greatly benefit from.

We are asking for your support by following our policy which in return will avoid extra cost as well as having to pass the cost to our parents.
